Accessing and Using CalOMS Tx Outcome Reports

Authorized county staff have online access to CalOMS through the ITWS. They can run CalOMS reports for their county as a whole or individually for local service providers that are under contract with the county. ADP encourages the counties to provide CalOMS reports to their county contracted providers and review the results with them.

4 Steps to Creating CalOMS Reports:

1. Log into ITWS with Username and Password
2. Navigate to CalOMS in ITWS
3. Select the Report Options
4. Retrieve the Completed Reports
